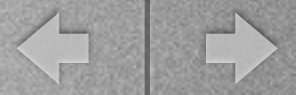

# Video formats

- MPEG-4 (.mp4, .m4v, sometimes .mpg, .mpeg)
  - most standard and compatible, recommended
- AVI - primarily Windows
- WMV - Windows Media
- MOV - QuickTime Movie
- FLV - Adobe Flash Video
- RM - RealMedia
- MKV - Matroska

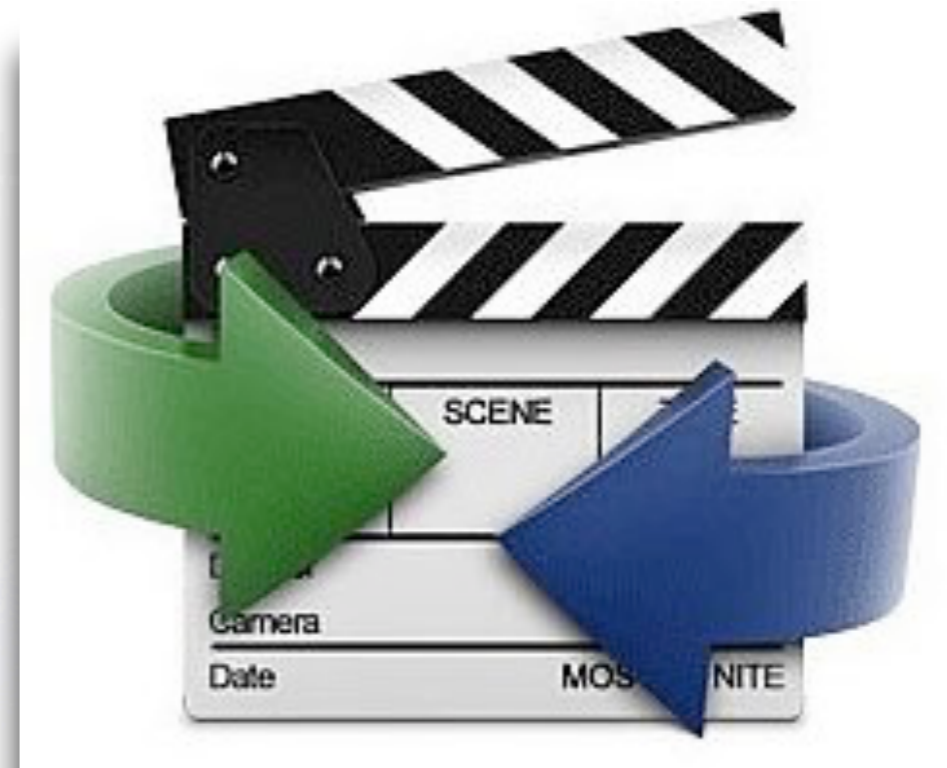

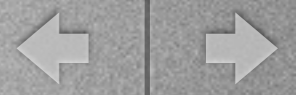

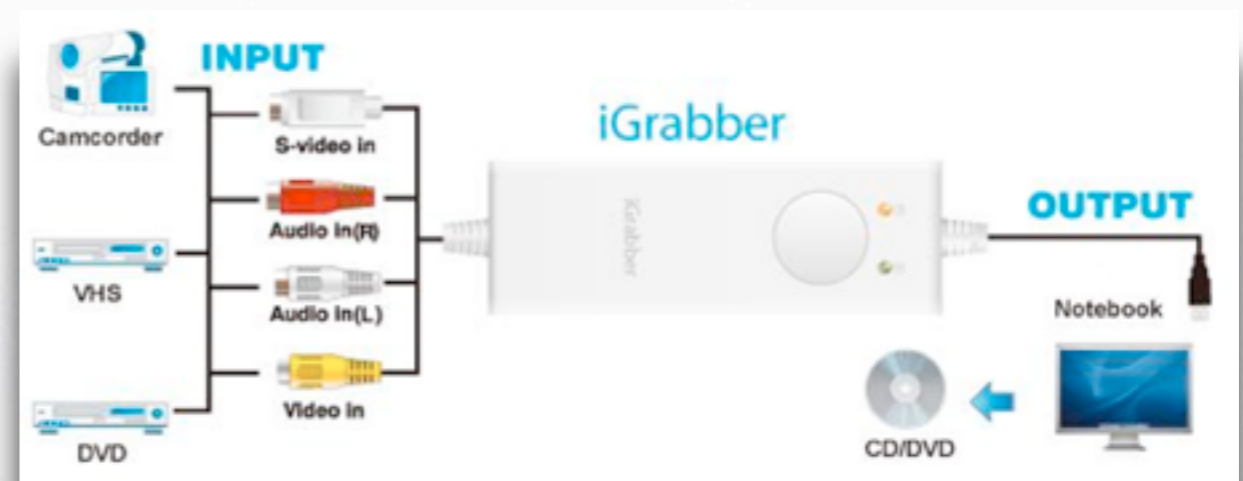
