DAVEY ELEMENTARY SUPPLY LIST 2010-2011

GRADE 1

1. 12 sharpened #2 pencils (not mechanical)
2. Two large pink erasers
3. Crayons (16 or 24 count only)
4. Scissors
5. White glue (washable – no paste)
6. 8 thick markers (washable)
7. 1 highlighter
8. 3 black dry erase markers
9. container to store above items (school box)
10. 1 white 1-inch binder with clear plastic cover

NOTE: PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING

We would appreciate the following items for our classroom use:

- 1) 2 boxes of tissues (family size)
- 2) 1 box plastic bags with zipper top (any size)
- 3) 1 bottle of hand sanitizer

GRADE 2

1. 20 pencils (not mechanical)
2. Two big erasers
3. Crayons
4. Scissors
5. White glue (suggest washable)
6. School box
7. Two 70-page spiral notebooks
8. Box of markers
9. Three pocket folders with prongs
10. Glue stick
11. 2 dry erase markers
12. 1 pack of looseleaf paper (wide ruled)

NOTE: No large (12" x 8") portable art sets, please

We would also appreciate the following items for our classroom use:

- 1) 2 boxes tissues (family size)
- 2) 1 box of plastic bags with zipper top (any size)
- 3) Disposable camera
- 4) 1 bottle of antibacterial hand sanitizer

GRADE 3

1. 1 package standard white, wide-ruled notebook paper
2. Glue sticks (3)
3. 24-pack Crayons
4. Scissors
5. Twenty #2 pencils (no mechanical)
6. Eraser
7. 3 pocket folders with prongs – NO TRAPPER KEEPERS, PLEASE
8. Markers
9. Small school box for supplies
10. One 1" binder
11. One 70-page spiral notebook wide-ruled
12. 1 package dry erase markers

We would also appreciate these items for our classroom use:

- 1) 2-3 boxes of tissue
- 2) 1 bottle antibacterial hand wash (no soap)
- 3) 1 package plastic bags with zipper tops (any size)

***NO PERSONAL PENCIL SHARPENERS, PLEASE.**

GRADE 4

1. Eight #2 pencils
2. Eraser (suggest gum eraser)
3. Scissors
4. White glue
5. Crayons – 8-pack only
6. Markers
7. Colored pencils
8. Three folders with pockets
9. Small school box for supplies
10. Ruler (metric and inches on same ruler)
11. Individual pencil sharpener
12. Standard white, wide ruled or narrow ruled notebook paper

GRADE 5

1. 2 packages standard white, wide ruled notebook paper
2. Twenty #2 pencils – regular or mechanical
3. Scissors
4. 2 glue sticks or 1 glue bottle
5. One single-subject spiral notebook
6. Colored pencils
7. Ruler (metric and inches on same ruler)
8. Highlighters
9. Individual pencil sharpener
10. Pencil top erasers
11. 2 ½"-1" three-ring binders
12. 4 folders with prongs
13. 1 package dry-erase markers
14. Crayons – small box
15. Pencil pouch or box

We would also appreciate the following items for our classroom use.

- 1) Two or three boxes of tissues (family size)
- 2) Two bottles of hand sanitizer
- 3) Baby wipes or disinfecting wipes

ART SUPPLIES – Children need the following:

1. Paint smock – ALL STUDENTS
2. Box of tissues
3. Supply box from classroom (children do not need an additional supply box; just the one from their classroom) with the following items: 2 sharpened pencils (not mechanical), pink eraser, white glue, scissors, crayons, markers. Please check that your child has their supplies periodically during the year.
4. GRADE 5: 1 2-pocket folder with center clips
20 sheets of notebook paper
