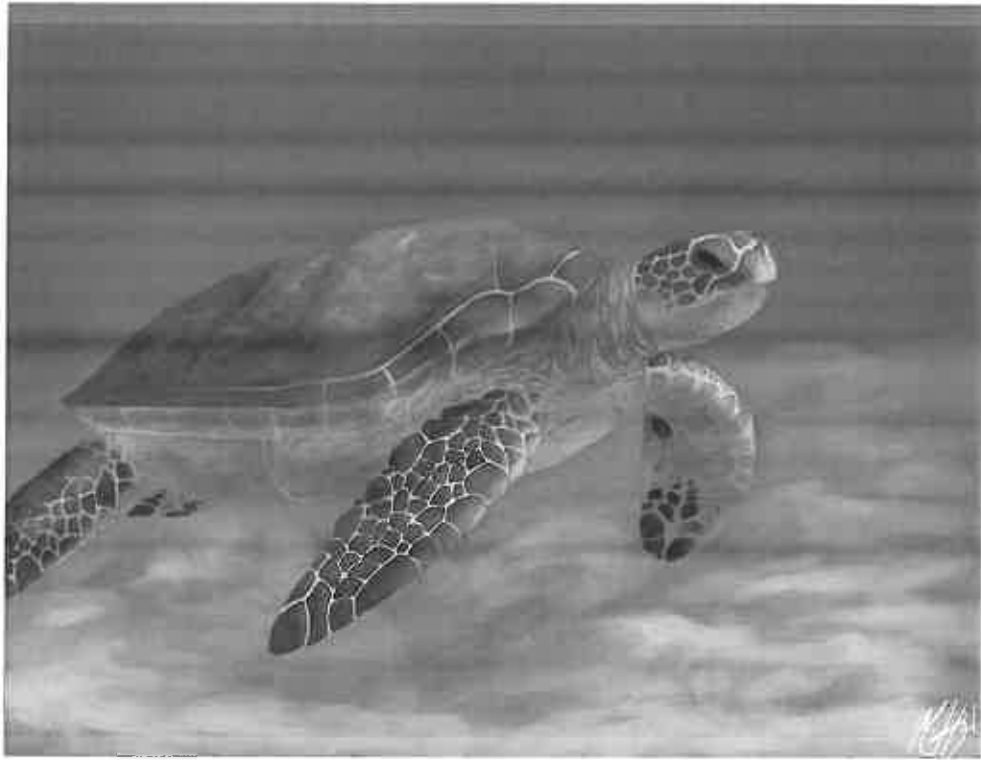


Elizabeth M. Hodgeman (Gonos) Memorial Scholarship



Background

This scholarship is designed to honor the memory of a loving and caring daughter and wife, Elizabeth M. Hodgeman (Gonos). Elizabeth (Beth) was a graduate of Kent Roosevelt High School (2010) and Kent State University (2014) and was the embodiment of a caring and supportive person. Beth was an active volunteer for many charities and causes. She was a tremendous supporter of our military personnel and their families. She also had a special affinity for sea turtles.

This \$1000.00 scholarship will be awarded to one Kent Roosevelt Graduating Senior that will be attending full-time classes at Kent State University. The candidate must exemplify the role of a volunteer with organization of the candidate's choice.

Requirements

To be considered, the student must:

- Graduate with a GPA of at least 2.75.

- Volunteer in at least two events for the organization of the candidate's choice. The organization can be a school group, club or organization for which the candidate volunteered or the organization can be external to the school (i.e. American Cancer Society, ASPCA, etc.).
- Attend Kent State University's Kent Campus full time.
- Provide two letters of recommendation. One from a Roosevelt faculty member and one from a charitable organization you have supported.
- Complete the following questions:

1. What does being a volunteer mean to you?

2. What organizations and events (dates and locations) have you participated in?

3. What future plans do you have for supporting charities of your choice?
