HUBER KING MEMORIAL ART SCHOLARSHIP

Purpose:

To support a Portage County High School student pursuing a four-year, undergraduate degree at an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning with a major or primary emphasis in art or art appreciation.

Who May Apply:

1. Any Portage County, OH High School Senior and resident of Portage County, OH.
2. The recipient must have been accepted and plan on attending an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning within one year following graduation.
3. The recipient must demonstrate:
 - a. Established educational and career goals,
 - b. Participation and commitment to school and/or community,
 - c. Scholarly pursuit by attaining a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA.
 - d. Demonstrated skill

Award:

This award will be given to a Senior attending a post-secondary institution, and the award will be given in the first year. The award is renewable for three additional consecutive years if area of study does not change and 2.5 GPA is maintained. It will be the responsibility of the award recipient to contact The Burbick Foundation to renew the scholarship in years 2-4 (copy of academic transcript and class schedule will be required).

Selection:

Selection will be based on an application made available through the school's high school guidance office. Upon completion of the application by a specified springtime date, the selection committee will evaluate the applicants. The selection committee will be comprised of The Burbick Foundation Scholarship Committee. The announcement of the selection will be made public at the high school's annual Scholarship Awards Program or as determined by the high school. The Burbick Foundation Scholarship Committee has the final determination of the scholarship recipient and can revoke said scholarship if criteria is not met and/or maintained.

Requirements:

1. A Portage County, OH High School Senior and resident of the Portage County, OH School District.
2. The recipient must have been accepted and plan on attending an accredited post-secondary institution of higher learning within one year following graduation.
3. The recipient must demonstrate:
 - a. Established educational and career goals,
 - b. Participation and commitment to school and/or community,
 - c. Scholarly pursuit by attaining a 2.5 or higher cumulative GPA.
4. Must have two character recommendations from a Faculty Member at their high school
