Scholarship Criteria for The Robert L. Wright RLW Scholarship

January 2, 2018

PURPOSE

The Robert L. Wright Scholarship Fund awards scholarships to college-bound high school seniors based on one or more of the following criteria demonstrated academic achievement (3.0 GPA), has gone through adverse situations (i.e. such as losing a loved one), has overcome physical obstacles and still perseveres, and is pursuing higher education, financial need, is a positive role model, and is involved in extracurricular activities/community service.

CRITERIA

The students eligible for this scholarship must be a graduating high school seniors who attends Theodore Roosevelt High School and intends to continue their education at a four-year college or university. Consideration will be given to academic achievement, financial need and the student's community service record. Students should submit (types or print clearly) the following application. A short essay where you must CLEARLY describe what adversity you have overcome, how you have been a positive role model, what community service you have been involved with, and an sport/activities you have been involved with. Please explain why you believe you deserve this scholarship. You must give a recommendation form to at least TWO teachers and one to a community service organization, activity advisor, or coach which describes how you have contributed to being "others" focused. Have a total of three recommendations turned in or sent directly to Roosevelt Guidance Office.

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GUIDELINES & AMOUNT

This scholarship will be awarded as a single lump sum of \$1,000.00 at the annual senior awards program in May at Theodore Roosevelt High School.

DEADLINES & SUBMISSION

The application deadline is March 23rd, 2018. The deadline is the date after which applications will no longer be accepted.
