

GUIDELINES FOR INDUCTION INTO THE KENT CITY SCHOOLS HALL OF FAME

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

- Usually two inductees in each category per academic year.
- At least 10 years between high school graduation and induction.
- Maximum number of inductees per year is six.
- Nominations will be accepted from the Hall of Fame committee, Kent citizens, faculty, students and graduates.
- Must be a graduate of Theodore Roosevelt High School with the exception of “Special Honorary Achievement” and “Major Contributions to the Kent City Schools” categories.
- Posthumous honors may be granted in any category.
- Nominations not selected will be filed for future consideration.
- Committee members will not be eligible for induction while serving on the committee.

CATEGORIES FOR NOMINATION:

ACADEMIC and CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Recognized as a respected leader in his or her profession who has demonstrated unique talents and accomplishments.
- Received academic recognition for his or her achievements while attending the Kent City Schools and/or college.

SCIENCE and TECHNOLOGY CAREER ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- Recognized as a respected leader in his or her profession who has demonstrated unique talents and accomplishments in the field of science and technology. Received academic recognition for his or her achievements while attending the Kent City Schools and/or college.

ATHLETIC ACCOMPLISHMENTS:

- Recognized for outstanding athletic accomplishments while attending the Kent City Schools such as setting new records at the district level or above, winning or placing in state competitions or ranking as an all-American. Recognized for athletic accomplishments at the college level, sand lot/semi pro or professional level.

CULTURAL and PERFORMING ARTS:

- Recognized for achievements in the cultural and performing arts and/or for contributions to the promotion of cultural activities on a local, state or national level.

MAJOR CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE KENT CITY SCHOOLS:

- Although not necessarily a graduate of Theodore Roosevelt High School, recognized for promoting the Kent City Schools and, by example or by sustained contribution, serving as a major influence in the lives of Kent students.

SPECIAL HONORARY ACHIEVEMENT:

- Although not necessarily a graduate of Theodore Roosevelt High School, recognized for special honorary achievement to the Kent City Schools and the Kent community.
