

## Important Information for the Start of the 2019-20 School Year

6<sup>th</sup> Grade Back to School Night will be held on Monday August 19, 2019. Back to School Night is an event for only 6<sup>th</sup> grade students and their families. 6<sup>th</sup> grade students will receive a letter in the mail from their 6<sup>th</sup> grade team. All 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will be able to find out their team placements on August 16, 2019 after 3:00 p.m. when homeroom lists are posted on the front and side doors at Stanton. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will not receive a mailing about their team placement. There is not a formal orientation or Back to School night event for 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students that were at Stanton last year. 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> graders and their families will be able to meet their teachers at the 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade Open House on August 29, 2019 at 7:00 p.m.

All 6<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, and 8<sup>th</sup> grade students will receive their schedules and locker assignments on the first day of school. All students should report to homeroom on the first day of school for Stanton, Wednesday August 21, 2019. Students that are taking Advanced Geometry at Roosevelt High School will start their day in Advanced Geometry 1st period at RHS on the first day of school. Advanced Geometry students will be assigned a locker at both SMS and RHS.
