

**Walls Elementary- Daily Plan and Procedures**  
**Let's Keep our School Safe!**

**\*Temperatures should be taken at home DAILY prior to leaving for school.** Any student with a temperature of 100 F or above must stay home from school and follow the Akron Children's Hospital Symptoms Chart Protocols (see Walls School website).

**\*ALL STUDENTS ARE REQUIRED TO WEAR MASKS AT ALL TIMES, ON BUSES AND INSIDE WALLS ELEMENTARY SCHOOL, EXCEPT DURING CIRCUMSTANCES INDICATED BELOW:**

- Breakfast- while eating only
- Outdoor Socially Distanced (6 FT) Mask Break with a Teacher
- Recess, where all students must be 6 ft apart AT ALL TIMES
- Lunch- while eating only

**\*\*Gators may be worn ONLY if they are double layered (wear two) OR are long enough to be folded into a double layer that covers the nose and mouth.**

**\*\*Shields may be worn, but must be worn with a mask.**

**Arrival:**

8:20 - Breakfast eaters enter.

8:30 - All other students enter.

8:40 - Tardy bell rings.

**Where do I go?**

- Walkers - as you enter school grounds, continue around the right side of the building to the back of the school, then branch off by grade level:
  - K-2 will enter at the recess door near the K-2 HALLWAY. You will stand 6 ft apart on marked spots prior to entering school.
  - 3-5 will continue across the recess blacktop to enter the doors by the 3-5 HALLWAY. You will stand 6 ft apart on marked spots prior to entering school.
- Car Riders will follow the usual traffic pattern (marked in lot) and will exit at the back corner of the building, near the 3-5 HALLWAY.
- Bus Riders will exit the bus at 8:20 (breakfast eaters) or 8:30 (all students) and walk directly through the main entrance. Bus riders will be dismissed one bus at a time, to allow for distancing. There will be NO CONGREGATING on the front walk.
- ALL STUDENTS WILL GO DIRECTLY TO THEIR CLASSROOM. We will not use lockers this year. Items will be stored in desks or under desks. Please pack lightly :)

**Recess and Lunch:**

- Students will be picked up at the classroom door by their monitor. They will sanitize before going outside.
- Students will need to play 6 ft from all others during recess. There will be no sharing of balls, toys, or other equipment.
- Students are encouraged to bring something from home if possible such as sidewalk chalk, jump ropes, balls, or other individual activities. NO items can be shared and play equipment/climbing gyms will not be in use.
- Students will sanitize prior to entering the building after recess to prepare for lunch.

- Monitors will walk students to get their lunch, and then back to the classroom for eating in their assigned desk.
- PLEASE DO NOT SEND FOOD THAT NEEDS HEATED, AS THERE ARE NO CLASSROOM MICROWAVES.
- Students will remove masks while eating, but will put masks back on when finished with lunch.

### **Specials:**

Students will travel to specials by walking in a safely distanced line on the right side of the hallway. There will be a 10-minute gap in between special classes to allow for disinfection . No items/materials will be shared during specials classes.

### **Bathrooms:**

Students will wait on designated marks inside the restroom to keep distanced. If the bathroom is full, students will wait outside the restroom on designated marks until space is available.

### **Water Filling Stations:**

-Students should bring their own water bottles for drinking, as drinking fountains will be closed, but the bottle fillers only will be utilized. Students will be permitted to refill their water bottles during the day. Stations are marked with floor stickers, safe distances apart.

### **Dismissal:**

Car riders and Walkers will be released by 3:15. Parents should arrive by 3:15 to eliminate congregating at the end of the day. Students will wait for pick up on socially distanced marks outside the Grade 3-5 recess door. Parents will need to stay in vehicles to keep safe social distance.

- Bus Riders will remain in their classroom until their bus is called on the PA system.
- Walkers - will exit the same way as they arrived.
  - K-2 will exit at the recess door and continue the same path taken for arrival.
  - 3-5 will exit the doors in the 3rd grade hallway and continue the same path taken for arrival.

### **General Guidelines for Safety:**

- Visitors will not be permitted during school hours UNLESS you have an appointment
- Parents bringing late students or picking up students early should:
  1. Ring the doorbell
  2. Talk with the secretary who will sign your child in or out
  3. Only the child will be let into the building
- Any items being dropped off should be placed on the table between the front doors.
- There will be no birthday treats this year because we are not sharing items.
- All students, remote and face to face, will report absences to Linda Putaturo, our school secretary as usual. Absence Line is 330-678-7500 or 330-676-8300.

- Our regular clinic will service any first aid needs. Any students presenting with COVID-19 symptoms will wait in a secondary clinic area to be picked up within 30 minutes.
